- Starting Stack: 30,000 tournament chips. Players start the tournament with 3 "life chips" worth 10,000 tournament chips each. Players have 4 levels during which to redeem their life chips as they see fit. After the 4th level, dealers will give out 10,000 tournament chips for every unused life chip. Players may use all 3 life chips to start the tournament.
- Blind Level Length: 20 minutes.
- Breaks: There will be 15-minute breaks after approximately every 4 levels of play.
- Late Registration: Players may enter the tournament until the beginning of Level 5 (end of the first break).
- **Re-buy rules:** This is a 3 Lives tournament. Each player may use his or her "life chip" as mentioned above. No other rebuy or re-entry is permitted.
- Players per table: This is an 8-handed tournament. The final table will begin at 9 players remaining.
- Seating Redraws: There will be a full redraw prior to the beginning of the final table (9 players).
- Tournament director decisions are final and players shall have no recourse following the beginning of the next hand. The next hand begins with the first riffle of the cards.
- Maximum players: 120 + alternates.
- 3% of the prize pool will be withheld as staff gratuities.
- Playground Poker reserves the right to limit seating, cancel or modify tournaments at its sole discretion and without prior notice.
